Admission requirements

Each exchange programme has its own specific admission requirements. You can find these on the exchange programme page under the header "practical matters – admission requirements".

Also, please be aware that we can't always guarantee that students will be accepted to their 1st programme preference (e.g. *due maximum capacity programmes or not meeting the requirements based on study background*). Therefore we will ask your students to indicate their programme preferences in the online application form: 1st, 2nd and 3rd preference. If we have to ask students to transfer to another (similar) programme, we will contact you and the student(s) as soon as possible during or shortly after the application period. Students, and partners, will be informed about the student's acceptance within 3 weeks after the application deadline.
