# HOW TO SELECT YOUR COURSES at Université Gustave Eiffel

# The French Higher Education System



**BAC:** National High School Exam in France

In France, students usually specialize in one field from their first year (L1).

They have a mandatory set of classes that they must attend every semester (30 ECTS credits).

# The French School System

## There are three different types of classes:

- Lectures (called **CM** - Cours Magistraux)
  - Auditoriums of large groups of students
- Tutorials (called **TD** - Travaux Dirigés)
  - Groups of fewer students
  - Apply the knowledge acquired in the lectures
- Practical Work (called **TP** - Travaux Pratiques)
  - Mainly dedicated to scientific fields
  - Undertake experiments in small groups

A mix of both is  
oftentimes used  
at the same  
course

**Attendance to both** is **mandatory** in order  
to pass

## Important

You may choose courses from six departments, four institutes and two schools. **However, you cannot choose courses from four member schools (EAV&T, EIVP, ENSG and ESIEE).**

When selecting your classes, keep in mind that some courses might be located at different campuses. Please refer to the "**Campuses of Université Gustave Eiffel**" section on this document for more information.

# Course Selection

## Please follow these simple guidelines :

- You must select a degree equivalent to yours (subject and level)
- In order to access to Master's degree courses, you need an equivalent Bachelor's degree
- Select courses from the same program of study to avoid any schedule issue
- Select courses dispensed during the semester you will spend at Université Gustave Eiffel
  - **Semesters 1, 3 and 5 = fall semesters (S1, S3 and S5)**
  - **Semesters 2, 4 and 6 = spring semesters (S2, S4 and S6)**
- Respect the minimum number of ECTS credits required per semester by your home university
- There is no schedule or syllabus available before September
  - **You might have to change a few of your classes upon arrival**
- Each degree has its own academic calendar
  - **Beginning of classes and examination sessions may vary**
- When completing the selection of your courses, indicate the full title of the course, the title of the degree, the year of study (i.e. the 2nd year of Bachelor's degree) and the number of ECTS credits for each course you have selected





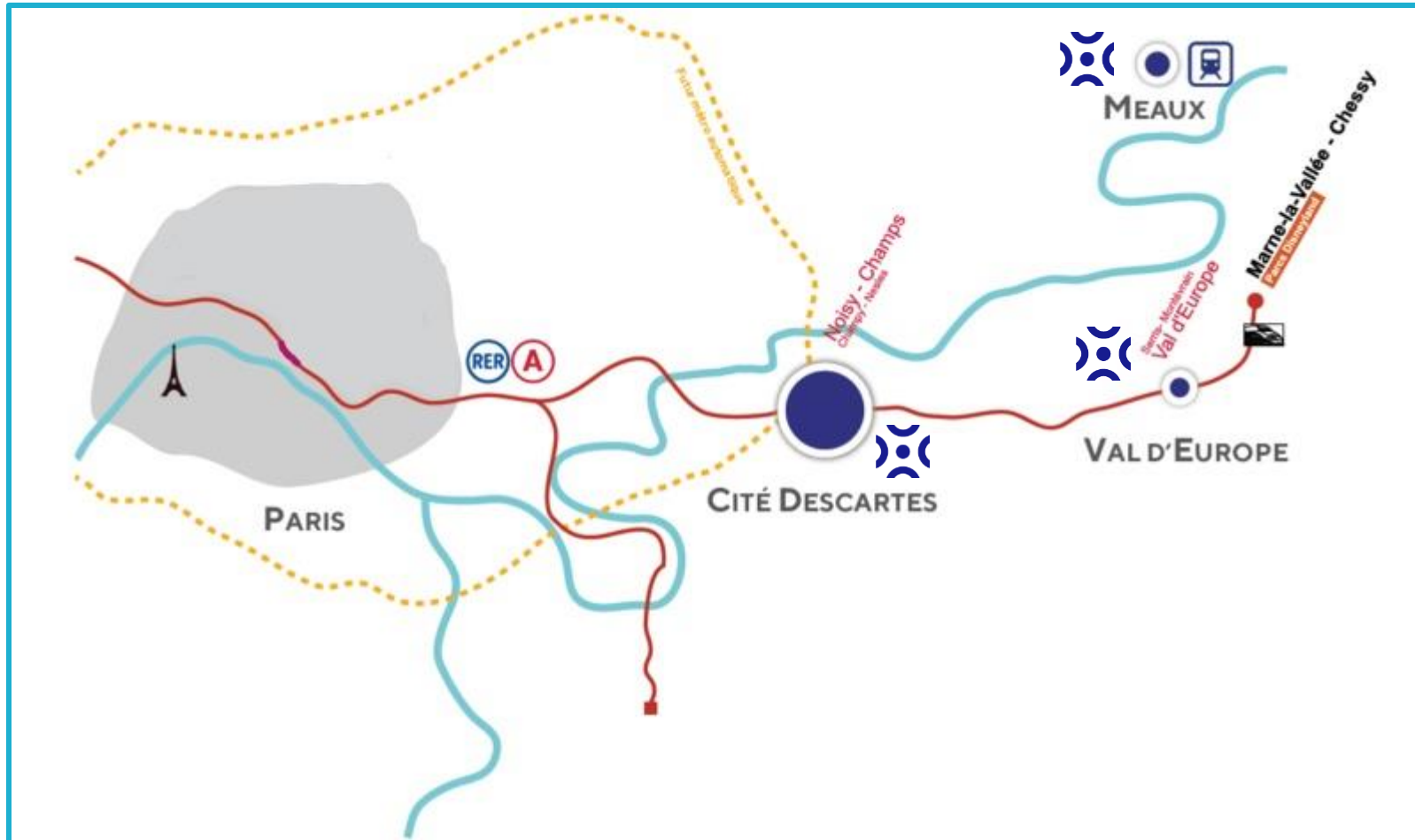
